Notice of Meeting

There will be a special congregational meeting after worship on Sunday, September 12. Our building suffered water damage along the west wall of the Fellowship Hall. To date the trustees have removed most of the affected drywall and insulation, and have had the room de-humidified. The carpet will be cleaned and deodorized this week. The room is safe, although unfinished.

The repair needs to proceed in two stages.

1. The trustees recommend excavating the foundation of the sanctuary building along the alley and installing a membrane, weeping tile and sump pump. It is hoped that this will prevent water entering the building in the future. The cost will be approximately \$10,000.
2. Installing fresh insulation and drywall. We are waiting for a quote for this work.

We have no funds in our 2010 operating budget for a project of this size, hence the need for a meeting to authorize the spending of these additional funds.

We appeal to our church family to help in this time of extra financial need, and to continue to support your church generously.
